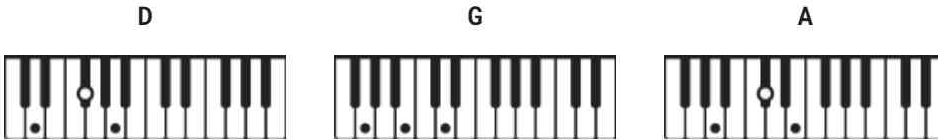

Capo: 7th fret

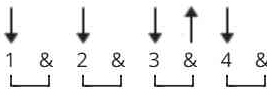
