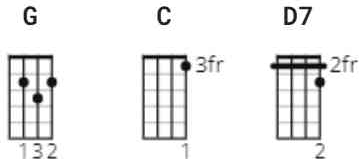


Jamaica Farewell Chords by The Kingston Trio

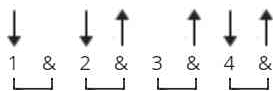
